Dear Mayor Bowser and Chairman Mendelson:

This letter informs you that the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) plans to begin the audit of the fiscal year (FY) 2022 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR), which will be conducted under project code OIG No. 22-1-26MA. As you are aware, the Mayor is required to "[s]ubmit to the Council, by February 1st of each fiscal year, a complete financial statement and report for the preceding fiscal year, as audited by the [Office of the] Inspector General of the District of Columbia"1

The OIG is required to contract with an independent auditor who is not an officer or employee of the OIG² to audit the complete financial statements and report on the activities of the District government for each fiscal year.³ FY 2022 represents the third year the OIG has contracted with McConnell & Jones, LLP (MJ). MJ will conduct this audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in Government Auditing Standards, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

MJ is also contractually required to review work papers of third-party CPA firms who audit financial statements of component units, organization units, funds, and programs.⁴ I am asking District agency leaders (copied on this letter) of entities audited by third-party auditors to ensure that the third-party auditors are engaged no later than August 12, 2022, and they express opinions on the entities' financial statements no later than December 14, 2022.

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I am also requesting that no later than June 15, 2022, District agency leaders copied herein provide this Office with a list of new accounting standards that the entities have implemented or plan to implement in FY 22.

During the audit, the OIG will host periodic meetings to monitor and oversee the audit process and facilitate communication among MJ, the Executive Office of the Mayor, the D.C. Council, the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, and other District management officials, and independent agencies.

Robert Binelli, Contract Administrator, will be reaching out to District agencies to arrange a kick-off meeting to introduce MJ, discuss the audit process, and answer questions. I also request that all District agency leaders who receive this letter provide a point of contact from their agency to Wanda Scales at wanda.scales@dc.gov by May 27, 2022.
