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**\$1.5 MILLION DOLLAR SETTLEMENT AGAINST MYLAN INC. FOR D.C.**

*Washington, D.C.* – Inspector General Lucas announced the District’s collaboration with participating states and the federal government in an agreement with Mylan Inc. and its subsidiary, Mylan Specialty L.P. (collectively “Mylan”), to settle allegations that they knowingly underpaid rebates owed to the Medicaid program for the drugs EpiPen® and EpiPen Jr.® (“EpiPen”) dispensed to Medicaid beneficiaries. This resolves allegations that from July 29, 2010 to March 31, 2017, Mylan submitted false statements to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (“CMS”) that incorrectly classified EpiPen and did not report a Best Price to CMS for EpiPen, which it was required to do. Mylan’s settlement with the United States also resolves allegations that Mylan Specialty overcharged certain entities (known as the “340B Covered Entities”) that participated in the 340B Drug Pricing Program.

As part of the settlement, Mylan, Inc. agreed to pay \$465 million to the federal government and states. Pursuant to the settlement, the District will receive \$1,527,145.14.
